

MILITARY Fee Assistance Programs



Operation Military Child Care (OMCC)

- Supports the temporary child care needs of military parents who are **activated or deployed**

Who's eligible?

- Families/legal guardians of the children of National Guard & Reserve Service members who are currently **activated or deployed**
- Families/legal guardians of the children of deployed Active Duty Soldiers, Sailors, Airmen, and Marines unable to access child care on military installations

Benefits to Military Families:

- Helps eligible military families locate licensed child care options in local communities
- Reduces child care fees through fee assistance

Military Child Care in Your Neighborhood (MCCYN)

- Supports military families with the cost of high-quality* child care outside military installations

Who is eligible?

- Active duty military families

Benefits to Military Families:

- Helps eligible military families locate high-quality* child care options in local communities
- Reduces the cost of high-quality* child care

Fee Assistance Application Process for OMCC and MCCYN

If the CCR&R receives questions from a parent about the fee assistance process, here are the steps a parent must take:

- Complete the fee assistance application located at www.naccrra.org/military or call the NACCRRRA Military fee assistance Department at (800) 793-0324, ext 341
- Provide the following documentation to the NACCRRRA fee assistance department by fax (703) 341-4104, or mail:
 - o military orders (activated/deployed only)
 - o most current military Leave and Earning Statement (LES)
 - o spouse's most current pay stub or proof of enrollment in school
 - o birth certificate of qualifying children or self-certification statement

Additionally:

- The selected child care provider must fill out the provider application and fax or send to NACCRRRA fee assistance department (fax number above)

**Refers to NAEYC, NAC, or NAA accredited centers or family child care homes that are NAFCC accredited, CDA credentialed or have an Associate's degree or higher in Early Childhood Education or Child Development*
